Minutes of the Jowett Society, Michaelmas Term 1930

IB was Secretary of the Oxford University undergraduate philosophical society, the Jowett Society, for Michaelmas Term 1930. The minutes of the three meetings held that term (like the relevant membership lists), are in his hand in the minute book, and signed by the President. Some of IB's erratic punctuation has been silently normalised in the transcripts below.

In a conversation with Gavriel Cohen, **bit.ly/GC-IB-12**, IB says he became President of the Jowett Society 'in the end'. The minutes show that he is misremembering. He is first recorded as attending a meeting on 27 November 1929; he was elected Secretary on 19 June 1930; he was never President (the year after his Secretaryship, when he might have been expected to fill that post, the President was H[arold] Jeffery Smith); his last recorded attendance as an undergraduate was on 24 May 1932 (by then he was an hon. Member, having sat Greats in 1931).

The 297th meeting of the Society was held in Mr. Houghton's rooms in Magdalen on Wednesday the 29th October at 8.15 p.m.

There were present besides the officers of the Society Mr. H. [sc. M.] L. G. Balfour, member, and Messrs Copleston, Halpern, McIver, Roberts, Barnes, Bodington, Smith, Houghton, Todd, Golt and Phipps guests. In private business the minutes of the previous meeting were read, and, after an amendment made by Mr. McIver, carried. Mr McIver pointed out that it had been decided to pursue *a continuous policy* of requesting college tutors to draw the attention of their pupils to the existence of the Society, and of the Society to the existence of their pupils. The Secretary then reported on the peculiar financial condition of the Society. In public business Mr A. M. McIver read a paper on The Realist Conception of Existence. A discussion followed, opened by the President, in which most of those present took part. All guests present were declared elected members of the Society. The Society adjourned at 10·40 p.m.

Kabir, Cleanth Brooks, H. P. Kingdom, guests. In private business the minutes of the previous meeting were read and carried. The President emphasised the duty of paying subscriptions. In Public business Mr. H. Jeffery Smith read a paper on a Philosophical Interpretation of Religion. A lively discussion followed, opened by the President, in which with one exception all present took part. The Society adjourned at 10.30 p.m.

Balfour and the Secretary; Messrs Kabir, Wordsworth, Phillips, Brooks, Turner were elected members of the Society. The meeting was adjourned at 10.45 p.m.
